THE CIVIL AVIATION (HELIPORTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Heliports) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Civil Aviation (Heliports) Regulations, 2024 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

Addition of
regulation
95A

2. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 95 the following new regulation:

“Suspension and revocation of licence, certificate, approval or authorisation

95A.-(1) The Authority may, where it considers it to be in public interest or on any reasonable ground provided under these Regulations, suspend provisionally, pending further investigation, any licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any such other document issued under these Regulations.

(2) The Authority may, upon the completion of an investigation which has shown sufficient ground to the Authority’s satisfaction and where it considers it to be in public interest, revoke, suspend or vary any licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any other document issued or granted under these Regulations.

(3) The Authority may, where it considers it to be in public interest, prevent operations at heliport.

(4) Where the Authority suspends, revokes or varies a licence, certificate,

approval, authorisation or any other document issued under these Regulations or prevent operations at heliport, it shall notify the heliport operator of its decision in writing.

(5) A holder or any person in possession or custody of any licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any such other document which have been revoked, suspended or varied under these Regulations shall surrender the licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or such other documents to the Authority within fourteen days from the date of revocation, suspension or variation.

(6) The breach of any condition subject to which any licence, certificate, authorisation or any such other document has been granted or issued under these Regulations shall render the document invalid during the continuance of the breach.”.

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation

98 by-

- (a) designating the contents of regulation 98 as subregulation (1); and
- (b) adding immediately after subregulation (1) as designated the following:

“(2) Where a holder of a suspended or revoked licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any such other document has rectified the contravention, the Authority may-

- (a) in the case of suspension, reinstate the licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any such other document; and

- (b) in the case of revocation, issue a new licence, certificate, approval, authorisation or any such other document upon application and fulfilment of requirements under these Regulations.”.
